Today our lives will change by the word and power and Word of God.

1. The Holy Spirit knows the person to whom you have been assigned. Ac 8:29.

Acts 8:29

Amplified Bible (AMP)

29 Then the [Holy] Spirit said to Philip, Go forward and join yourself to this chariot.

2. The Holy Spirit will send inner warnings to protect you from wrong people and places. Ac 16: 6-7.

Acts 16:6-7

Amplified Bible (AMP)

6 And Paul and Silas passed through the territory of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to proclaim the Word in [the province of] Asia.
7 And when they had come opposite Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not permit them.

3. The Holy Spirit is saddened by wrong conduct Ep 4: 30-31.

Ephesians 4:30-31

Amplified Bible (AMP)

30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God [do not offend or vex or sadden Him], by Whom you were sealed (marked, branded as God's own, secured) for the day of redemption (of final deliverance through Christ from evil and the consequences of sin).

31 Let all bitterness and indignation *and* wrath (passion, rage, bad temper) and resentment (anger, animosity) and quarreling (brawling, clamor, contention) and slander (evil-speaking, abusive or blasphemous language) be banished from you, with all malice (spite, ill will, or baseness of any kind).

4. The Holy Spirit critiques ever motive, moment, and movement of your life. Jer 17:10.

Jeremiah 17:10

Amplified Bible (AMP)

10 I the Lord search the mind, I try the heart, even to give to every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his doings.

5. The Holy Spirit becomes an enemy to the rebellious. Is 63: 10.

Isaiah 63:10

Amplified Bible (AMP)

10 But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit; therefore He turned to become their enemy and Himself fought against them.

6. The Holy Spirit withdraws when offended. Ep 4:30-32, Hos 5:15.

Hosea 5:15

Amplified Bible (AMP)

15 I will return to My place [on high] until they acknowledge their offense *and* feel their guilt and seek My face; in their affliction *and* distress they will seek, inquire for, *and* require Me earnestly, saying,
