Amplified Bible (AMP)

21 From that time Jesus began to show to His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day.

22 Then Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "Far be it from You, Lord; this shall not happen to You!"

23 But He turned and said to Peter, "**Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.**"

What has been the thing that has caused you to less than God intended for you?

Has pain been a part of your upbringing causing you to hate a Father? Has this translated into thinking of Father God as less than He is in your life?
God wants your relationship with your Father healed today!

GET BEHIND ME SATAN!

What hateful words were spoken to you in your life? Who told you that you were a failure?
Who told you that you would never succeed?
Who trod on your dream and made fun of what you dreamed of?
Can you forgive them today?

Matthew 18:21-35

Amplified Bible (AMP)

21 Then Peter came up to Him and said, Lord, how many times may my brother sin against me and I forgive him *and* let it go? [As many as] up to seven times?

22 Jesus answered him, I tell you, not up to seven times, but seventy times seven!

23 Therefore the kingdom of heaven is like a human king who wished to settle accounts with his attendants.

24 When he began the accounting, one was brought to him who owed him 10,000 talents [probably about \$10,000,000],

25 And because he could not pay, his master ordered him to be sold, with his wife and his children and everything that he possessed, and payment to be made.

26 So the attendant fell on his knees, begging him, Have patience with me and I will pay you everything.

27 And his master's heart was moved with compassion, and he released him and forgave him [cancelling] the debt.

28 But that same attendant, as he went out, found one of his fellow attendants who owed him a hundred denarii [about twenty dollars]; and he caught him by the throat and said, Pay what you owe!

29 So his fellow attendant fell down and begged him earnestly, Give me time, and I will pay you *all*!

30 But he was unwilling, and he went out and had him put in prison till he should pay the debt.

31 When his fellow attendants saw what had happened, they were greatly distressed, and they went and told everything that had taken place to their master.

32 Then his master called him and said to him, You contemptible *and* wicked attendant! I forgave *and* cancelled all that [great] debt of yours because you begged me to.

33 And should you not have had pity *and* mercy on your fellow attendant, as I had pity *and* mercy on you?

34 And in wrath his master turned him over to the torturers (the jailers), till he should pay all that he owed.

35 So also My heavenly Father will deal with every one of you if you do not freely forgive your brother from your heart *his offenses*.

But Let's go back just a little, lets look at the word in context.

Matthew 18:19-20

Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, make a symphony together) about

whatever [anything and everything] they may ask, it will come to pass *and* be done for them by My Father in heaven.

20 For wherever two or three are gathered (drawn together as My followers) in (into) My name, there I Am in the midst of them.

Agreement is a powerful thing.

When your friend comes to you and starts to gossip about a neighbor, what is your response?

“Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.”

or do you agree with them, feeding the conversation, making the situation bigger.

How we deal with stuff is very important to God. How we think about things is very important to God. He is looking at us and listening to us all the time. Knowing that we have an antagonist in our midst who is determined to break down everything God is trying to do in our lives.

6 Blessed and fortunate and happy and spiritually prosperous (in that state in which the born-again child of God enjoys His favor and salvation) are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness (uprightness and right standing with God), for they shall be completely satisfied!

“Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.”

7 Blessed (happy, to be envied, and spiritually prosperous—with life-joy and satisfaction in God’s favor and salvation, regardless of their outward conditions) are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy!

“Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.”

8 Blessed (happy, enviably fortunate, and spiritually prosperous—possessing the happiness produced by the experience of God’s favor and especially conditioned by

the revelation of His grace, regardless of their outward conditions) are the pure in heart, for they shall see God!

“Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.”

9 Blessed (enjoying enviable happiness, spiritually prosperous—with life-joy and satisfaction in God’s favor and salvation, regardless of their outward conditions) are the makers and maintainers of peace, for they shall be called the sons of God!

10 Blessed and happy and enviably fortunate and spiritually prosperous (in the state in which the born-again child of God enjoys and finds satisfaction in God’s favor and salvation, regardless of his outward conditions) are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake (for being and doing right), for theirs is the kingdom of heaven!

“Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.”

11 Blessed (happy, to be envied, and spiritually prosperous—with life-joy and satisfaction in God’s favor

and salvation, regardless of your outward conditions) are you when people revile you and persecute you and say all kinds of evil things against you falsely on My account.

12 Be glad and supremely joyful, for your reward in heaven is great (strong and intense), for in this same way people persecuted the prophets who were before you.

13 You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste (its strength, its quality), how can its saltiness be restored? It is not good for anything any longer but to be thrown out and trodden underfoot by men.
