### **1 Peter 5:7**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

7 Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully.

No peace for the wicked.

Give all problems and care to the Lord.

Kids, will do my best to solve my kids problems.

This behavior was given by the Lord for the same reason as himself.

### **Matthew 6:25**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

25 Therefore I tell you, stop being perpetually uneasy (anxious and worried) about your life, what you shall eat or what you shall drink; or about your body, what you

shall put on. Is not life greater [in quality] than food, and the body [far above and more excellent] than clothing?

26 Look at the birds of the air; they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father keeps feeding them. Are you not worth much more than they?

27 And who of you by worrying and being anxious can add one unit of measure (cubit) to his stature or to the span of his life?

28 And why should you be anxious about clothes? Consider the lilies of the field and learn thoroughly how they grow; they neither toil nor spin.

29 Yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his magnificence (excellence, dignity, and grace) was not arrayed like one of these. [I Kings 10:4-7.]

30 But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and green and tomorrow is tossed into the furnace, will He not much more surely clothe you, O you of little faith? **Clue to the issue here.**

31 Therefore do not worry and be anxious, saying, What are we going to have to eat? or, What are we going to have to drink? or, What are we going to have to wear?

32 For the Gentiles (heathen) wish for and crave and diligently seek all these things, and your heavenly Father knows well that you need them all. **Prayer meetings of problems, NO.**

33 But seek (aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (His way of doing and being right), and then all these things taken together will be given you besides.

34 So do not worry **3 times in this passage** or be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will have worries and anxieties of its own. Sufficient for each day is its own trouble.

If God said don't murder, would it be a sin to murder?

commit adultery?

Lie?

Worry? Next time you take care, quote Philipians 4:6-7.

### **Psalm 34:19**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 Many evils confront the [consistently] righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all.

To every promise in the Bible there is a God side and there is a man side.

**Conf: it is God's plan that I am delivered from all my problems, all my afflictions.**

### **Luke 10:19**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 Behold! I have given you authority and power to trample **does not mean our physical feet** upon serpents and scorpions, and [physical and mental strength and

ability] over all the power that the enemy [possesses]; and nothing shall in any way harm you.

### **Isaiah 26:3**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

3 You will guard him and keep him in perfect and constant peace **what kind of peace?** whose mind [both its inclination and its character] is stayed on You, because he commits himself to You, leans on You, and hopes confidently in You.

How do we fix our mind on Him?

The Word!

### **John 1**

1 IN THE beginning [before all time] was the Word (Christ), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Himself.

**Conf: When I put my mind on the word, faith comes trust comes peace comes. Peace comes when I put my mind on him, worry goes, when my mind is fixed on Him.**

### **Matthew 11:28**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy-laden and overburdened, and I will cause you to rest. [I will ease and relieve and refresh your souls.]

**Conf: Must come from Jesus no where else.**

## **John 16:23-24**

### **Ask, because God wants me to have joy.**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

**23** And when that time comes, you will ask nothing of Me [you will need to ask Me no questions]. I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, that My Father will grant you whatever you ask in My Name [as **representing** all that I AM].

**24** Up to this time you have not asked a [single] thing in My Name [as **representing** all that I AM]; but now ask and keep on asking and you will receive, so that your joy (gladness, delight) may be full and complete.

## **2 Timothy 1:7**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

**7** For God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.

Fear is a demon

Worry and fear is not from God, worry opens a door to the devil and closes the door to God's help and opens the door to the devil.

## **Job**

Job was the Reason his problems came his way.  
Fear is faith in what the devil might do to me.  
Misplaced faith.

## **Job 1**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

**1** THERE WAS a man in the land of Uz whose name was Job; and that man was **blameless and upright**, and one who [reverently] feared God and abstained from and shunned evil [because it was wrong].

**2** And there were born to him seven sons and three daughters.

**3** He possessed 7,000 sheep, 3,000 camels, 500 yoke of oxen, 500 female donkeys, and a very great body of servants, so that this man was the greatest of all the men of the East.

**8** And the Lord said to Satan, Have you considered My servant Job, **seems like a strange question. Why would God draw attn to satan?** that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who [reverently] fears God and abstains from and shuns evil [because it is wrong]? **What a compliment! Imagine God spoke this about you.**

**9** Then Satan answered the Lord, Does Job [reverently] fear God for nothing?

**10** Have You not put a hedge about him and his house and all that he has, on every side? **This means that satan had tried to attack job but could not. because of the hedge.**

**Conf: God protects me my property, my car everything.** You have conferred prosperity and happiness upon him in the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land. **God is the one who blesses. Notice that God is the same yesterday today and forever.**

## **Hebrews 13:8**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

**8** Jesus Christ (the Messiah) is [always] the same, yesterday, today, [yes] and forever (to the ages).

**11** But put forth Your hand now and touch all that he has, and he will curse You to Your face. **This must have frustrated the devil.**

**12** And the Lord said to Satan (the adversary and the accuser), Behold, all that he has is in your power, **Why would God do this to Job? Why would God give him permission? GOD CANNOT PROTECT US IF WE WORRY!** only upon the man himself put not forth your hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the Lord.

**Lets take careful note of what method the devil used to attack Job.**

**13** And there was a day **did not happen over a week or month it was one day** when [Job's] sons and his daughters were eating and drinking wine in their eldest brother's house [on his birthday],

**14** And there came a messenger to Job and said, The oxen were plowing and the donkeys feeding beside them,

15 And the Sabeans swooped down upon them and took away [the animals]. Indeed, they have slain the servants with the edge of the sword, and I alone have escaped to tell you. **The devil can use people to steal from people.**

16 While he was yet speaking, there came also another and said, The fire of God (lightning) has fallen from the heavens and has burned up the sheep and the servants and consumed them, and I alone have escaped to tell you. **The devil can use lightning.**

17 While he was yet speaking, there came also another and said, The Chaldeans divided into three bands and made a raid upon the camels and have taken them away, yes, and have slain the servants with the edge of the sword, and I alone have escaped to tell you. **The devil can use people to kill and steal.**

18 While he was yet speaking, there came also another and said, Your sons and your daughters were eating and drinking wine in their eldest brother's house,

19 And behold, there came a great [whirlwind] from the desert, and smote the four corners of the house, and it fell upon the young people and they are dead, and I alone have escaped to tell you. **The devil can use wind to attack us.**

**Notice that this all happened in one day.**

**Jesus and disciples in the boat. Wind was from the devil. and he rebuked it.**

**Devil can use natural circumstances.**

21 And said, Naked (without possessions) came I [into this world] from my mother's womb, and naked (without possessions) shall I depart. The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; blessed (praised and magnified in worship) be the name of the Lord! **Job did not know what happened during God's conversation.**

**God did not instruct the devil. He is a loving Father.**

**Every statement in the Bible is correctly stated, but every statement is a statement of truth.**

**Everything that was recorded was truthfully stated but it may not be the truth.**

**When the pharacies came and accused Jesus of knocking down the temple did Jesus say this? Was it true, did Jesus say that he would do that? no, he was talking about his body. but it was a stated truthfully.**

**Thats why we have to rightly divide the scriptures.**

## **2 Timothy 2:15**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

**15 Study and be eager and do your utmost to present yourself to God approved (tested by trial), a workman who has no cause to be ashamed, correctly analyzing and accurately dividing [rightly handling and skillfully teaching] the Word of Truth.**

**John 10:10 Thief comes to steal kill and destroy.**

**God's greatest desire is to bless.**

## **Hosea 4:6**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge;

## **Job 3:25**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

25 For the thing which I greatly fear comes upon me, and that of which I am afraid befalls me. **In other words Job has been worried about lightening, raiders and wind.**

The thing I greatly feared has come upon me.

Conf: Fear and worry closes the door of God's help that's why God could not protect Job from the devil any longer.

Fear and worry opens the door for the devil to do exactly what I am worrying about.

26 I was not or am not at ease, **Listen to his confession!** nor had I or have I rest, nor was I or am I quiet, yet trouble came and still comes [upon me]. **Lets see how Jesus explains this.**

## **Job 16:14**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

14[Satan] stabs me, making breach after breach and attacking again and again; he runs at me like a giant and irresistible warrior.

## **Mark 11:23**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

23 Truly I tell you, whoever says **conf: surely meaneth me** to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him.

**Conf: whoever says whatever he says will come.**

**Whoever means saved or unsaved, heathen or non heathen.**

**Secular people know this and speak rightly and have the blessing but what about Christians.**

### **Job 42:10**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

10 And the Lord turned the captivity of Job and restored his fortunes, when he prayed for his friends; also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before.

**God is extravagant:**

**Too much fish it Peter sank two boats**

**Wedding feast enough**

**Enough oil**

**Loaves and fishes 12 basketfuls over.**

### **Philippians 4:6**

Amplified Bible (AMP)

6 Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving **Must do it with thanksgiving**, continue to make your wants known to God.

7 And God's peace [shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

8 For the rest, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely and lovable, whatever is kind and winsome and gracious, if there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think on and weigh and take account of these things [fix your minds on them]. **Where do you find this? In the word.**

**Conf: When I have a need I need to go to the word.**

- 4) Keep giving thanks
